- **\$2/week** provides a diagnostic hearing evaluation to a low-income senior citizen.
- **\$5/week** provides developmental screenings to 5 low-income children who are at risk for developmental delays and disabilities.
- **\$10/week** provides one week of basic daily needs and care for a child who has been removed from an abusive home.
- **\$15/week** covers the cost of GED exam fees for 2 individuals looking to build a better life for themselves and for their families.
- **\$20/week** provides summer academic and cultural enrichment activities for a student at risk of dropping out to help set him/her on the path to high school graduation.
- **\$25/week** provides 71 hours of respite care to support and reduce stress for families and caregivers of Alzheimer's patients.
- **\$30/week** provides a week's worth of groceries for 15 families in need.
- **\$40/week** provides 3 weeks of therapy to 3 children with developmental disabilities and special needs.
- **\$50/week** provides 4 victims of domestic violence with 6 months of education and emotional support through a family violence intervention program.
- **\$75/week** provides dental care and oral health screenings for 34 low-income patients in Greenville County.
- **\$99/week** provides literacy skills and pre-GED courses to prepare 13 adult education students for the first step towards gainful employment and self-sufficiency.
- **\$144/week** provides 4 children from low-wealth neighborhoods, who are most at risk for not being ready for school, with three months of full-day preschool.
- **\$193/week** purchases 350 prescriptions and refills for low-income, uninsured Greenville County residents.
