

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I donate backpacks and supplies?

If you have fully packed backpacks to donate, you can drop them off on July 24–25 from 9 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. at Feed & Seed Co. **Please ensure that donated supplies are new and unopened**.

All backpacks and supplies will be distributed to Greenville County students in all grade levels.


Where can I drop off my backpacks and supplies?
